We are located only 17km from Chirundu and just upriver from the confluence of the Kafue River and the Zambezi River in the Lower Zambezi area. We offer clean, comfortable, self-catering, furnished accommodation. We are also able to facilitate and arrange for activities on behalf of our guests including fishing, boat cruises and seasonal game drives.

We offer self-catering accommodation, and as such all guests are required to bring their own food and drinks. The property is fully serviced by an experienced compliment of staff including a chef who will create your meals how you like them. The team are available to clean the rooms and kitchen area.

Tiger Fish Cabins



The Tiger Fish Cabins consist of three large air-conditioned chalets that can sleep up to 12 guests. Each chalet has one double bed and two single beds with en-suite facilities (toilet, sink and shower). We provide bed linen, towels and mosquito nets for each bed. The chalets share a separate kitchen dining and lounging area that is fully equipped with an electric stove and oven, fridge and freezer.

Cheesa Cottage



Chessa Cottage is a two bedroomed cottage with ensuite bathrooms in each room sleeping a total of four people. The cottage boasts an open plan living, kitchen, dining area with a veranda overlooking the Zambezi River. The kitchen is fully equipped with an electric stove with an oven, fridge and freezer. We provide bed linen, towels and mosquito nets for each bed.

- The property is in a Game Management Area, therefore guests are encouraged to be careful as there
 are wild animals around.
- The lodge is supplied by Zesco and we provide backup power for fridges and lights in the kitchen, dining lounge areas, and solar lights in the chalets and cottage rooms.
- Water is sourced from a borehole and safe to drink but we always recommend that guests carry their own drinking water.
- A travel cot is available for babies on request.
- Smoking is NOT allowed inside any of the buildings, including the kitchen/diner area.

Directions to Winterthorn Lodge

• At Chirundu heading to the border, turn left at Chirundu Mall onto Chiawa Road (a dirt road).

2 graters

- Drive for 10km until you reach Chiawa Bridge.
- After the bridge please contact us on 0761919434 / 0975608500 and let us know that you have arrived at the bridge so the team can be at the gate for your arrival.
- Cross the Bridge and drive 1km until you reach a 4-way stop. Take the road to the right, heading to Lower Zambezi National Park.
- Drive for 6km until you reach a large Baobab tree on the right-hand side.
- Our green gate is immediately after the Baobab tree signed Winterthorn.
